Thirty minutes later, Twinn and Xavier XL Lewis penned and recorded, HoodFly an instant work of art with his female fan base. The Miskeen Dream is already making it happen like the majors should be. Akademiks has stepped up and supplied him wardrobe for his most recent photo shoot in the M. I. A. with Miskeen Originals soon to follow. Twinn is also getting involved in his community. Man, Im just trying to make a better tomorrow for not only my family, but for my community, Young Twinn expresses whole heartedly. I just want for everybody to know that Tomorrow is Coming. Dont get it twisted; this is not a campaign. If youre young and bettering yourself through schooling, training, community service, etc. youre Tomorrow right along with me.
