Dafnis band had grown so comfortable playing together during a year of regular performances that they recorded the basic tracks for all of these songs livevocals includedin a single day at producer Charlie McGoverns Big OI Studio in North Hollywood (two of the songs were later rerecorded on another dayagain live), providing the album with a consistency that captures the vibe of the bands shows. In addition to 11 of Dafnis original compositions, Charlies Lonely Sunday contains a Cajun-style cover of labelmate Tracy Huffmans Bottom of a Well and a country rompthe saucy Down and Dirtyco-written with L.A. songstress Sarah Stanley.
