The disc features 17 dynamic Funky Mama originals and arrangements showcasing a voice that kids music authority Bill Childs calls rich, soulful, and bluesy. As an on-air reporter for Kansas City ABC affiliate KMBC-TV Channel 9 News, Krista Tatschl Eyler earned an Emmy nomination, covering everything from fires to homicides to tornados. After five years of this intense, on-the-edge life, she became the ultimate crossover artist - Funky Mama - singing for kids in a bold, straightforward, funk/soul style that's imbued with a strong sense of narrative phrasing and dynamite energy! A favorite among families in Kansas City, Funky Mama scored national recognition when she performed at the 2007 White House Easter Egg Roll in Washington, D.C. Only a handful of nationally recognized entertainers nationwide are invited to play the

Roll each year. On Moo Juice, Eylers powerful blues drenched voice sounds like she would be right at home anywhere: singing with any of the great soul singers of the 60s, creating stunning dialogue with a flute in a stylish calypso, taking the stage at the Grand Ole Opry, singing folksy jug band standards, belting one out with the best of Louisianas Zydeco bands, or soaring over the top of a mesmerizing up-tempo gospel group. Mostly though, Funky Mamas music is just plain fun. Moo Juice is energy personified. Funky Mama sings with an intrinsically deep rhythmic sense that urges on all her terrific back-up musicians. Her internal rhythm is especially noticeable on Down, Down, Baby and Can You Hear Me? where Krista Eyler sings a capella, backed by the rhythmically tightest group of kids on record. Rhythm is what gets kids attention, and this CD is loaded with it. Krista offers refreshingly down home, powerful singing for a generation of kids who dont often get to hear vocalists with the ability to project their voices while still retaining clarity of diction. Krista has a big voice, and its always easy to understand the lyrics. Other Moo Juice highlights include No Sleep Tonight (smokin fast-piano-vocal-driven gospel), Sippy (a sippy cup song thats straight-up Southern Rock), My Dad Rocks (a minor key samba), and the albums title track (up-tempo rock n roll, graced by Tulsa Reads soulful harmonica solos). As is appropriate for a CD to be released just before Grandparents Day, Moo Juice also includes The Grandparent Name Song, a Beach Boys-esque tune in which Funky Mama ruminates on the many different ways to name a grandparent. Says Krista Eyler, Ive been singing in musical theatre and playing guitar since I was 15. I started performing for kids in 2005, when I saw that there was a niche to be filled. After I had my first son, I became aware that there were some great dad acts out there, but no Funky Mamas! What I want most is to teach kids is to love music and dancing with their whole hearts, just as I do. Krista Funky Mama Eylers previous CDs include Funky Mama Sings: Giggle Jiggle (2005) and Grandmas House (2006). Krista Eyler is also the author of a childrens book, Funky Mama's Grandma's House (2007). Funky Mama is the real thing, with two funky boys and a funky daddy to show for it.
