Recent CDs he plays on include: "Portal" (Origin Records) with the Deardorf/Peterson Group, "Canto do Rio" (Liquid City) with Jovino Santos Neto (nominated for a Latin Grammy), and his own CD "Lucky" (Origin Records). JENNIFER IVESTER (vocals) has toured the world with the Larry Elgart big band, whose album "Hooked On Swing" is the biggest selling swing album of all time. She is also a widely recorded studio musician whose work is heard on major Seattle stations as well as hundreds of others across the United States. MARK IVESTER (drums), Jennifer's husband, is a first call studio musician in the Seattle area. He has worked with Mel Torme, Charlie Byrd, Buddy DeFranco, Freddie Hubbard, Michael Brecker, Larry Coryell, Clare Fischer, Cannonball Adderley, Bud Shank, Mose Allison, and Herb Ellis. EUGENE BIEN (piano) is one of the top keyboard players in the Pacific Northwest. Virginia in a house filled with the music of Beethoven, Brubeck, Dylan, Chopin, and church hymns. In elementary school he played piano and drums, but in junior and senior high he opted for the alto sax and flute. At Pomona College, Steve played in the jazz band under the direction of Bobby Bradford. When Steve had to become an adult, he put music on hold, moved to Seattle, and got a Ph.D. in Biostatistics from the University of Washington. In the late 1980's he began playing sax again, studying first with Johnny Jessen, and then Don Lanphere. In the Fall of 2000, a piano that needed to be babysat rolled into Steve's life, and six months later he began taking piano lessons. Since then Steve has written jazz, country, and pop songs. His first collection of jazz songs is "Wrapped Up in Your Kiss", which he produced and was recorded by Quintessence. Steve currently lives in Seattle with his wife and son.
