Her musical history is deeply rooted in gospel, blues, and bluegrass. "My mother was a singer and my grandfather was a preacher with a haunting and powerful singing voice," says Hopkins. "It was really like blues to me." Carrying on this musical legacy, she has taken it to a new level, playing lead, rhythm, and slide guitar. She currently tours with the Donna Hopkins Band, playing original material as well as unique arrangements of classic blues and rock. Her trademark vocal style has been compared to such classic voices as Janis Joplin and Bonnie Raitt. "Growing up 45 minutes from Muscle Shoals, where some of the most important American music was produced, has been a huge influence on me," she says. Hopkins released her debut album Free to Go in March, 2003.
