He was working wedding with the Marty Stevens band and Marty Stevens had past, but at the funeral he realized that something was missing in his life. You see the Marty Stevens band was a family of musicians comprising of his two sons and himself, so at the funeral they played songs in their father's memory and Rob realized that they were

blessed because of that. So he decided to start singing with his mother. Finely he called his mother and she felt that his music was anointed.
