These bonus tracks, recorded in concert in the Great Hall of the Folger Shakespeare Library with an outstanding array of vocalists and instrumentalists, have been re-mastered to blend seamlessly with both the Latin pieces that begin the CD and the English carols that end it. All of these selections show a great variety of musical styles, learned and rustic, complex and engagingly simple; yet they have the telling of the Christmas story in common. We have rounded out the recording with a few instrumental selections that fit the spirit of the season.
