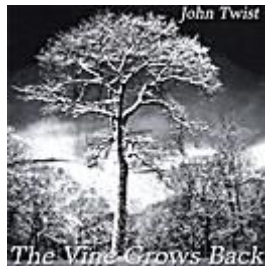


Mp3 John Twist - The Vine Grows Back
