She was the first woman to win the cable ACE for Best Standup Comedy Performance, and the first woman to perform at the elite White House Correspondents dinner where she shared the dais with the President. Paulas late night talk show appearances include David Letterman, Jay Leno, Conan OBrien and Craig Ferguson. She also makes guest appearances on Garrison Keillors A Prairie Home Companion. Despite these many accolades, Paula insists on spending the bulk of her time at home in Santa Monica with her three children, Toshia, Allison and Thomas E. She says, things have never been better.
