The Musicians: JP Ferris' electric guitar rhythms lay the foundation for many of Camel Toe's get-up-and-dance tunes. JP's lead-guitar solos are blistering hot, and his whacked-out humor comes through loud and clear on the microphone. Doug White holds down the low

end with innovative bass lines, slappin' poppin' and finger-funkin' his electric 4-string. Dean Vellenga's drumming prowess anchors every Camel Toe song with perfectly placed drumbeats, fills and cymbal hits. Dean's formal education in music, and his extensive playing experience in bands, ensembles, and theater productions adds a creative spark to Camel Toe's on-going writing and performing.
