What Pinnacle Rhythms decided to do is go a completely different direction. "As a producer, I'm not much of an emcee" Shaun says. "But does that mean I can't release an album?" Well if you ask Pharell Williams of the Neptunes, or DJ Muggs, or Tony Touch if that's the case, they would emphatically deny that statement. In fact, all of them have done the unthinkable.
