
## Mp3 Tom Eslick Live In Concert - Folk: Gentle

Gentle Modern Folk 13 MP3 Songs FOLK: Gentle, FOLK: Modern Folk Details: This CD was recorded live, August 27th, 2005 at the Norris Family Theater, Proctor Academy, Andover, New Hampshire as a benefit concert for the Wilmot Community Center, Wilmot New Hampshire. About the Artist: Tom Eslick, a New Englander for most of his life, grew up with a guitar in one hand and a copy of Shakespeare's collected works in the other. He has taught English for more than thirty five years on both secondary school and college levels. Tom is also well known regionally as a professional songwriter and singer with several albums to his credit. He recently released a CD of his original compositions. Tom began his teaching career at Vermont College. During that time, he often sang at local ski areas, including the Trapp Family Lodge in Stowe, Vermont, where he was house musician for six years. He now teaches at Proctor Academy in Andover, New Hampshire, having served also as the English Department Chair for nineteen years. Increasingly drawn to fiction writing, Tom earned an M.F.A. in Creative Writing at Boston's Emerson College a few years ago. Soon thereafter, his first mystery, the critically acclaimed TRACKED IN THE WHITES was published by Write Way Publishing in 1997. The first printing quickly sold out and the book was released in paperback by Harlequin World Wide Publishing in late 1999. His second mystery, SNOW KILL, was released in May 2000; his third, DEADLY KIN was published by Viking in September, 2003, and his fourth, MOUNTAIN PERIL, also with Viking, in March 2005. Tom's forte is delivering fast-paced, action-packed mystery plots made vividly plausible by a strong sense of place, believable characters, and everyday, real-life situations in which things go horribly wrong. Tom is currently writing songs, teaching, performing, and working on a new novel.
