----- Mark Weigle's 2nd release, 'All That Matters' finds him growing in a more contemporary, pop direction, while still keeping his roots firmly planted in the folk/country of his first disc, 'The Truth Is'. Lyrically, Weigle continues to tell engaging stories that explore gay life experience, from the sexy, morning-after romp, "A Good Day", (Billboard Magazine's 'Unsigned Record of the Year') to the title track, told from the perspective of an elderly gay man who's just lost his lover of many years, who finally finds the courage to tell the truth in order to honor their relationship. "John" is a poignant look at a married man's first experience with another man, set in an adult bookstore booth. While the story is told in a straightforward manner, it is not mined for laughs, nor shock value, but instead expresses the emotional upheaval of a man finding his true self at last, and facing the consequences.
