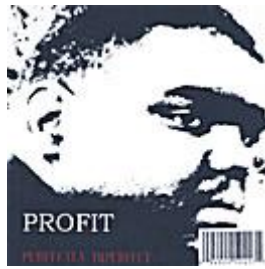


Mp3 Profit - Perfectly Imperfect

"Profit" aka Tobias Smith grew up in a single family home, raised by his father. The Chicago native began producing and performing at the age of 15. He received extreme critical acclaim in the Detroit hip-hop arena with his first album "Black Feeling, Black Talk." His father, Timothy "Bama" Smith, a Radio T.V. professional, saw the raw talent in his son and began teaching him basic music principles. But to make sure "Profit" was ready for the music industry, his dad
