includes professional performing on saxophone, violin and voice and his conducting resume includes work with symphony orchestra, choir and jazz band. His composition credits include music for theatre, dance, published vocal arrangements and forays into everything from jazz and electronica to avante garde classical music. Don has scored music for films featured at all the major film festivals and in 2000 his score for Cannes Film Festival winner "Shoes Off" was recognized as "one of the most compelling original scores attached to any Canadian film, ever......"
