Experimenting with everything from hip hop, drum n bass, techno, rock to R&B. Mitch Law is also a budding film director. Qalo: Outkast meets the Wu-Tang Clan..." Chicago has rapidly become the Mecca of hip-hop's triple threat - the super producer-writer entertainer. No longer second to any metropolis, Chicago has launched this brand of superstar by giving us R. Kelly, Kanye West and now, the band, Qalo. Newly signed to Universal Motown, this quartet of hip-hop thoroughbreds has been hailed by the likes of XXL, Billboard Magazine, The Source, YRB, Complex magazine, the Chicago Sun-Times and even Playboy magazine! Qalo, meaning "The Four.", consist of rapper-producers: Preast, Chicago Shawn, Optimyst and Shala Esquire. The four come together with an energy similar to the heydays of the hip hop super-group. This seldom-seen combination makes their musical reach wide and addictive. They have hooked up with WGCI-FM 107.5's DJ Mike Love to become the Midwest mixtape kings, and have had their latest release "Believe" praised by critics around the nation. Bottomline: a definite franchise... Preast delivers soul-touching, picturesque rhymes with a lyrical depth paralleled only by such greats as Pac, Nas, and Eminem. Chicago Shawn adds a stick of dynamite to the recipe with a high octane flow to match his intricate wordplay and introspective sentimentality. Adding fuel to the fire is Optimyst. Optimyst lends his distinguished wordplay, commanding the listeners' attention. His compelling "prose" style verses possess a quality of simple sincerity and clarity; a kin to musical icons, Outkast. Shala Esquire adds a catchy, speech-style flow to the band engaging the listener in a one-way conversation and a humorous call to arms. A native Nigerian, Esquire is the proverbial glue, anchoring the Qalo sound. A renaissance man,

in his own right, he is easily the next "Diddy"; as much as he hates and denies it. Each of the members of Qualo contributes to the group's production. From Esquire's unique rock-inspired bangers, to Preasts' cutting edge 80's style fire, to Chicago Shawn's sense of sound and Optimyst's ear-snatching creativity, all four contribute to the Qualo sound - a unique blend of fierce rhyme techniques, sincere street narratives, infectious chants and catchy hooks, set to a backdrop of bass-heavy beats, soulful music, social awareness, and political satire. "Qualo exhibits what most of the greatest bands of our time have often demonstrated; they seem to be totally oblivious of what the world of music is doing at any given time but it always manages to be hot and right on time". While the music is an experience in itself, Qualo's true essence can only be captured by seeing their live show. Qualo captivates the audience with a stage presence that is both exciting and inviting. They possess a synergy and presence rarely seen in this post-new school hip hop era. Whether you're a "hip hop purist", a radio junkie, or a rap critic, if you put your ear to the street and listen closely, you'll hear and be quickly entranced by "the hood's heartbeat"...the Qualo sound.

T. Riffic: After spending eight years in the army, Chicago native Torrence Burnett decided to give a career in music an earnest shot. Basing his operation in Ft. Worth, TX, Burnett made a name for himself as a songwriter and producer. Now, he's stepping into his own as a singer under the name T. Riffic as he goes for adds with "Where Is He?" taken from his upcoming debut album, tentatively titled True Story. Says T. Riffic about taking his career to the next level, "It's time for me to finish what I started. I have always been a man with so much to sing about, and now it's time to sing about it!"

GINA ROSE: Stayin true to R&B' is the term that suitably fits MD/DC songster GINA ROSE. With her distinctive, soulful voice, she easily grasps the attention of music lovers any and everywhere she is heard. Taking the music scene in the Washington D.C. metro area by storm, she has performed at major area clubs and events such as Adams Morgan Day Festival, Mitchellville Largo Kettering Community Day, and Unifest, which draws nearly 400,000 people. In January 2006 she was featured in Hoodfellaz Magazine as well as the Podcast on Singersroom.com. Recently her song "Never Felt This Way" was chosen to be in the independent film 'AFFECTED: THE AIDS PROJECT' for BGM Inc., 'Films Of Zion' in Los Angeles California. Her single "GOT U GOT ME" featuring produced by Plaboy-Chi (JIN former 'Ruff Ryder', MTV) has been streaming heavily on Internet websites, the Producers on the Grind [P.O.G] Mix tape Vol. 2, soon to make crucial noise in the clubs and on the streets.

His sound has mass appeal and is laced with the kind of flavour and style that it takes for longevity in the entertainment world. Singing since the age of 5, Kareem has honed his craft to perfection. At the young age of 16, he has already become a multitalented singer, producer and songwriter. Kareem has even contributed to the production of his first two videos. He has already completed 225 songs in his 32 track digital studio and has committed to a daily goal of completing one song a day.
