The second, "Always Remember These Days", is dedicated to the memory of First Sergeant Patrick Moran, 10th Louisisana Infantry, Company 'C' of the Army of Northern Virginia. Irish born Patrick was 50 years old and married when he enlisted at Camp Moore, Louisiana on July 22, 1862. He was the oldest man in the Regiment to surrender at Appomattox Court House on April 9th, 1865. This music is of an era when songs told stories and were part of an oral tradition of handing down historical events before the advent of recordings and radio. To that end, Hardtack Hamrony are committed to keeping history alive through their music.
