Without a current recording contract and completely independent, he has recorded a CD that reflects a bit of what the early country singers that have went on to be major label greats have done. With his influences and sounds coming respectfully from the likes of Keith Whitley, Alan Jackson, George Jones, Randy Travis and Merle Haggard just to name a few but most powerful, Rich Skaggs has not forgotten what's needed to keep the "country" in the music. He penned the thirteen songs that make up this CD. When asked he says in his own words, "I don't consider myself to be a good songwriter, I just put my thoughts and feelings to music and hope the point gets across somehow." From the time you first push play to the very last track on this CD, you will find yourself thinking of the simple things in life and how short it really is. After listening to the songs, "Little Angel", "Lost Without You" and "I Wish" your heart strings will be gently tugged with a jolt of heartfelt sighs thrown in the mix.
