The album covers many textures and styles from smooth 70s soul, 80s rare groove classics and RN'B to hip-hop, pop and UK garage all with a strikingly real urban backdrop. Hailing from South London, he has been working in the industry now for a steady 10 years, during which he has honed his song writing skills and picked up life experiences along the way, all of which filters through his work creating a clear sense of identity in his music. The issues Wayne openly covers range from bitter break-ups to strangely erotic unrequited love and even a celebration of friendship but all share the same crisp vocal delivery and clean production that makes this album stand out. His rich, soaring vocals and harmonies are laid over varying styles, creating an instantly enjoyable 3-D sound. The initial single Keepin Secrets and its accompanying video gained much airplay in 2005, including a top 10 position on the Genesis FM chart and now he continues his success with the release of the upbeat floor filler: His second single, 'Family Affair' carries a funk-pop vibe strong enough to make even the most shy and retiring get on that dance floor and boogie with its positive and uplifting message and slamming guest rap from Mz. Fontaine. The track has also been given the once over by DJ Chris Brophy, making the Infective Remix a funky house classic sure to be on the hit list with this year's Ibiza crowd. Wayne Latham has been part of the UK homo-hop collective QFam for the past 3 years and has lent his vocal, song writing and production talents to many members of the crew including rapper QBoy. The pair teamed up vocally

on Wayne's production of Quarter Life Crisis that is currently featured on the independent US film soundtrack for OpenCam. QBoys hit E.P. Even The Women Like Him was also executive produced by Wayne. On top of this he has worked with new talent Katanya, remixing her recent Channel U number 1 hit Father and handling production on the upcoming single When Did You Come In, which is already a hot favourite on underground radio. He has toured and performed a great deal gaining a worthy stage presence, playing dates in Manchester, London, Brighton, Cardiff, Hamburg (Germany), Zagreb (Croatia), and this past summer he played a breathtaking full set with QFam in Oslo, Norway for EuroPride followed by another top performance at this year's PeaceOUT UK festival. Wayne Latham's Urban Showcase has also been a continuing success in 2005; a live performance arena created by Wayne which displays the talents of singers and rappers from the UK urban scene. This year sees Wayne already starting work on his sophomore album, this time he is letting other producers on board to help create new space in his sound and push it further. Looking forward to promoting album over the next few months, he is down to perform at a host of festivals leading into the summer as this year carries great promise for his creation: Novena.
