He also studied South Indian Music (carnatic) at the Sweelick Conservatory of Amsterdam. He has won several international contests such as Grand Prix International dAccorden in St. Etienne (France 1988), Trofeo Mundial C.M.A. in Cuenca (Spain 1990), Premio Citt di Castelfidardo (Italy 1990) and Arrasate Hiria (Basque Country 1994).
