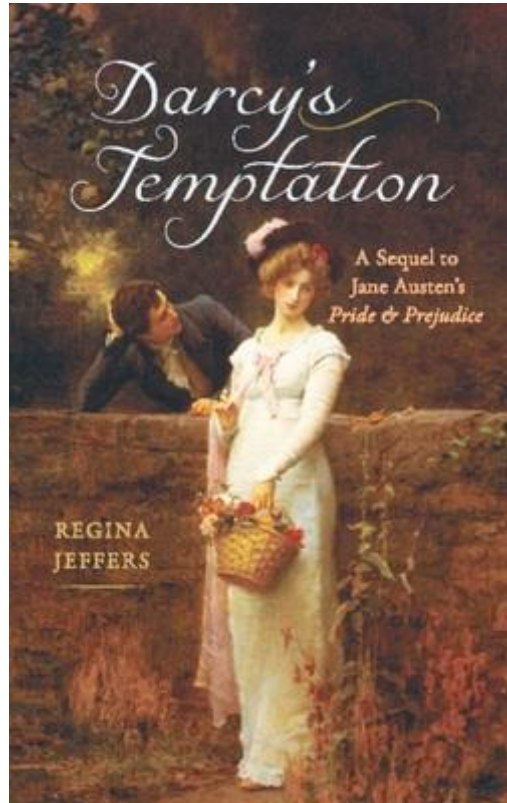


Darcy's Temptation: A Sequel To Jane Austen's Pride And Prejudice - Regina Jeffers
