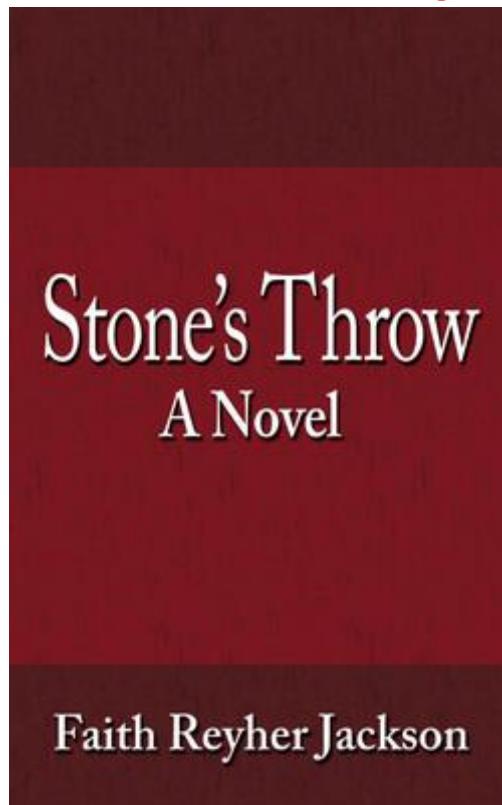


## Stone's Throw - Faith Reyher Jackson
