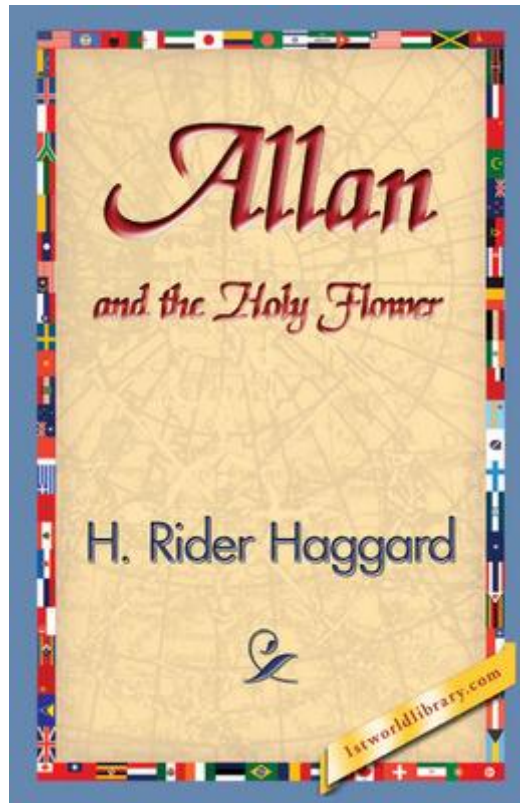


Allan And The Holy Flower - H. Rider Haggard
