Subsequent to this period, he recorded his 1st single entitled; "HIP-HOP PHENOMINAL" on Zakia records (a subsidiary of Profile Records). Q has worked with Prince Markie Dee (previously with the "Fat Boys"); Corey Rooney (who has worked with such artists as Mariah Carey Mary J. Blige); Brian Chin (who worked A&R for Chemistry Records distributed by Mercury Records); Engineer: Andre Debourge ("Record Lord"). Jon-Q's expertise is in production arrangement. He has worked on such studio equipment as the SSL Neeve mixing boards. He creates music on the Korg Triton music workstation/sampler the EMU system, SP 1200 sampler/percussion machine. He has worked in such recording studios as, "The Hit Factory," "Power Play," "Sony Studios," "Battery," "Unique," "Bayside Sound," "Cheung King Studios."
