This 5 week stretch at 1 granted her the opportunity to open for national recording artist, RayJ in May of 2008. In 2009 her emotionally driven song Last Tear, written for those experiencing long distance relationships, held the 1 spot again for 5 weeks on Buffalos hip-hop and R&B station 93.7 WBLK. These two successes awarded her nominations for Female R&B Artist of the Year and Single of the Year in Upstate New York

at the 2009 Unsigned Hype Music Awards. Ultimately, Rachel won the "Female R&B Artist of the Year" award. Another recent success includes placing 3rd in Showtime at The Apollo's Amateur Night in Harlem, New York. In late 2008, Rachel placed 2nd in the U. S. Army's Operation Rising Star National Singing Competition in Texas. Rachel has what it takes to succeed in this industry. With her drive and determination, she is destined to make it happen. Her versatility in music has opened doors for great collaborations. She sings and writes R&B and soul tracks while also dabbling in the hip hop genre.
