The name of the group is taken from the army of General Emiliano Zapata, who, in the Mexican Revolution of 1910, rose up in arms against the dictator Porfirio Daz. Zapata hoped to eradicate the precarious conditions under which farmers lived and to create a more just Mexico. As its name suggests, Imgenes is a gathering of expressions with emotions ranging from joy to reflection to pain to criticism; with topics including social issues, immigration, and repression of our indigenous brothers and sisters; covering geographical regions such as Chiapas, Michoacn, and the U.S.A.; and demonstrating rhythms like the son abajeo purhepecha, the corrido, pre-Hispanic recreations, and haunting Andean sounds.
