

Discovered and tutored by the great Eddy Arnold, Kimes is an accomplished songwriter who penned the platinum hit "Bury the Hatchet" for Garth Brooks as well as hits for Diamond Rio, Gene Watson and many others. A self-proclaimed "traditional artist who writes even more traditional music," Kimes' lyrics conjure up hard-clay images of wild horses, lost loves and humble cowboys -- the kind of raw, unashamed songs that pick at the soul and make the heart hurt. Kimes vocals are sometime lonely, sometimes tough, but always solid and to the point. Weaving his haunting tales of the West, Kimes music has a sense of openness that allows the listener to wander through his world. A two time winner of the Academy of Western Artist's Will Rogers Award, Kimes latest release, the acclaimed "Cowboy Cool," was voted one of the top 5 CDs of 2004 and continues to receive top reviews from publications like True West Magazine and Country Music People. "I'm a Cowboy," which appears on "Cowboy Cool," debuted at #1 on Power Source Magazine's Western

Chart for July 2005. On Kimes' CD, "A Dyin' Breed," he is joined by pal Garth Brooks on the sultry hit, "Night Birds," which went top 40 in the states and #1 in Europe. His newest effort, SNOW, comes just in time for the holidays. Not since Bing Crosby and Dean Martin, has anyone done these Christmas classics justice like RWK. His version of "White Christmas" will bring tears to your eyes and his original holiday tune, "Mistletoe" is soon to be a new Christmas classic.
