I constantly have to deal with stress in my life. The song "Think On Beautiful" reminds me (and maybe you too) to take my thoughts captive and give them to Christ that I might remain in His peace. "Around this Table" celebrates the family.... and family gatherings. Until we can gather around the heavenly table where no one will ever
