However, Guy's love for Jazz has led to the formation of his group, GEQ, the (Guymon Ensley Quintet). In a search for key members of the band, Guy recruited bassist, Kerry Lacy. A native of Ohio, Kerry began his music career playing gospel in his hometown church. Extensive study with numerous nationaly known bassist, helped him find his nitch in jazz. Kerry is a indespensible member of GEQ. Guy rounded out the rhythm section with Phil Lesky on keyboards and Bang Glenn on drums, both of whom bare many credits to their careers. Phil and Bang, along with Kerry Lacy, blend to form that unique "GEQ style". To the front line, Guy recruited GEQ's newest member, saxophonist, Robert Reeves. Although, primarily an alto player, robert doubles on tenor and gives just the right amount of that classic "sax" jazz flavor to the group's sound.
