"The Ballad of Lorna Hawkins", a song about anti-drive-by shooting crusader, Lorna Hawkins, was used in conjunction with The Million Mom March. Songs from her CD, "mend", are getting airplay on "The Midnight Special" radio show hosted by Rich Warren, as well as on several internet stations. Linn comes from a family of performing musicians. She studied music education at the University of Illinois, and arranging and composition at Berklee College of Music in Boston.
