The SERAPHYMNS CD was written, recorded, and produced over a period of two years and over a distance of 3000 miles between these three, with many internet and telephone hours logged within the journey between conception and completion. The intricate and evocative soundscapes crafted by Keith Gillard surround and support the powerful five octave voice of Sen Mealing, as their writing styles fold neatly together to form unique pieces of music... infusing electronic pop with classical, jazz, and soul sensibilities. The engineering finesse of John Fyssas provides the clarity and crystalline finish to each track, completing this triad of professionals with the sort of meticulous craftsmanship needed to bring each song to life.
