12 MP3 Songs POP: Folky Pop, FOLK: Folk Pop Details: Sophie Haviland and Alex Asch have been making music together since they were teenagers. Though Haviland lives in NY, she regularly visits Australia where she and Asch collaborate on creating original music. The songs on this album span a range of visits to Australia over the past 15 years and reflect the changing circumstances of the heart in transit. The style is a peculiar blend of Boston blues, NY jazz and Canberra folk. These songs have been played not only by Haviland and Asch, but also by other musicians in the backyards of Canberra for years- and have now been recorded for the first time. When they are not making music, Haviland and Asch work in other creative mediums. Alex Asch, who lives in Australia, is a visual artist who creates installations and artworks using found objects. His work has been shown at numerous galleries in Australia and Los Angeles and he has received several grants and awards for his pieces. His works have been included in permanent collections at galleries and museums in Canberra. Sophie Haviland is a writer and director who lives in New York. She is the founder of the Bridge Project- a film and theater collaboration that produces new performance works in countries all over the world. Her work with the Bridge Project has included collaborations in Australia, Portugal, United Kingdom, Germany and Japan. As a producer and theater artist she has worked both in New York and internationally. Collaborations include: Richard Foreman, Ontological/Hysteric Theater, Bang on a Can, Ridge Theater, Three Legged Dog, California Institute of the Arts and the filmmaker Hal Hartley. Her first novel, the Anthropologists Daughter will be published in 2007.
