Barbara Beeman is also featured on a Tom Wesselmann (pop artist) song called "Pictures on the Wall of Your Heart" which is on Jeff Gordon's Artsounds Collaborative record. Besides Spare Change, Barbara Bill have produced recorded "Candy From Strangers," "Moving Day," and "So The Story Goes." The first two were recorded with Larry McBride of Marimac Records. Other musicians featured on their recordings include Ted Dunn (electric guitar), Rob Hunter (banjo playing father of Charlie Hunter/also recording engineer) Tony Gutierrez,(drummer), Drew Smith (autoharp).
