In addition to his extraordinary talent, he brings perspective from various angles to whom he accredits Almighty GOD for his many experiences (good and bad), a breathe of fresh air with his content and not to mention, one of his closest friends and the other half of his rap group 5th Lane, VISION. Through the first half of his childhood, his mother (the only parent he had) worked long hours to support them.
