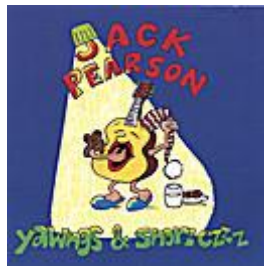


Mp3 Jack Pearson - Yawngs & Snoriezzz
