After working in clubs, and as a second engineer in a Santa Barbara recording studio, Stacy returned to Los Angeles where he settled as a staff songwriter at Almo/Irving Music. He moved from California to Nashville in 1994, and built Downstairs Sound Recording Studio as a place to work on his own music. "Before I knew it I had other people coming to the studio to do their recordings", says Stacy, who now works with a constant stream of Nashville writers and artists when he is not working on his own music. Mark has released 3 "Phonograph" Records" CDs "At this Table", "naked", "COLICCHIO". "Singer-songwriter Mark Stacy's new COLICCHIO". album is full of nuance and subtlety and other things of which good songs are made..." says Peter Cooper of THE TENNESSEAN. His work has been featured on NPR's Car Talk, NBC Sports 2000 Olympics. He engineeres and produced projects for other artists and writers at his Downstairs Sound Recording studio, where he also records his own music. Mark tours coffeehouses and bookstores as a solo performer where he sells his CDs.
