Willie grew up in one of the harshest environments imaginable only to manage to keep his nose out of trouble and eventually accepted into the prominent University of California, Davis. He also battled a serious lifetime weight problem and at 16 (influenced by Isidro), decided to make the changes to lead a disciplined and healthy lifestyle. Transformed both physically and mentally, Willie is focused and ready to step onto the scene with a vengeance. There is no doubt music will be another victory for Willie and this young man is working hard to make sure everyone knows that he will have the last laugh. Excited, eager, and geared up with the proper tools to climb this mountain, Willie is determined not to let anything get in his way. "Rejection feels terrible, but it motivates me even more to prove to all of them [nay-sayers] that they're wrong and show them what they've missed out on. It's payback time!"
