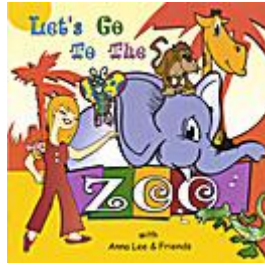


Mp3 Anna Lee - Let's Go To The Zoo

The imagery used in the songs will make children feel as if they are actually at the zoo looking at the animals! Whether children go with their families, friends, or a class - everyone knows it is a great way to spend the day! "Let's Go To The Zoo" prepares for such a trip before, or use afterwards as a follow-up on recalling such a day well spent or imagined! The CD provides lyrics and an activity guide inside that suggests 5 ways to enrich each song. It is a rhythmical, engaging adventure...sure to make your little one want to hear again and again. From beginning to end, it is full of finger snapping, hand clapping, toe tapping, moving and grooving music! Children will smile, sing, and dance along with Anna Lee and her little friends as they discover what a memorable day the zoo offers to us all. The target age for this CD is 1 - 8 years old. Give yourself a treat and take a moment to listen and hear the singing, music, and sound effects for yourself! Anna Lee is a singer, songwriter, teacher, and co-founder of Awesome Learning Productions. Prior to founding ALP, she freelanced for a top name in the education industry (Frank Schaffer Publications) and helped develop a series of children's videos, cassette tapes,

and activity books, which were published as the "Anna Lee Sings" series. Over the years, she has performed in California, Texas, New England, Arkansas, and Tennessee. In addition to live concerts, she presents educational workshops for children and in-service workshops for parents and teachers. Anna Lee's songs have been featured on PBS television for an Emmy winning children's show. She remains an active member of the Memphis Songwriters Association and Nashville's Songwriters Guild of America. Anna Lee continues her focus on children's music by integrating its appeal into her public school classroom. Using music as a teaching tool, children find that learning is easier, more fun, and much more effective! Anna Lee's philosophy is to make all subjects, especially reading, more meaningful with songs and music. She feels that by providing singable lyrics and catchy melodies for parents and teachers, adults will reminisce their youth while introducing children to the everlasting power of music.
