Montana Artists Refuge's first release, it is music that CINCHA wrote during one of several summers' residencies there and recorded with Montana musicians. As the Refuge's first composer, CINCHA established a lovely precedent, weaving Montana's beauty into her music. Her songs are "... evocative of the Montana landscape both in lyrics and instrumental work", according to the Lively

Times, who also noted "Among my favorite tracks, 'Stars Down to the Ground,' a poetic ode to the clear nighttime Montana sky." Performing jazz as "Cynthia Hilts", CINCHA has performed solo and led several ensembles over the years, playing mostly her original compositions. Her jazz groups have included many masters of jazz. She has played festivals, concerts and clubs in New York City, around the US, Europe, Mexico, Madagascar, and Tunisia, and recorded with the French and Swedish National Radios. Her jazz trio CD "Second Story Breeze" was released in 2008.
