Steffen has played at the 21st Woodstock reunion, the famed Bluebird Cafe in Nashville, Cruise ships, the 4 Seasons Resort in Nevis, BWI, and South Florida venues including Silver Springs, Margaritaville @Universal Studios Orlando, and Cypress Gardens. He plays originals, pop, reggae and island covers on acoustic guitar with his band "Offshore4", to a broad spectrum of travelers and locals eager to soak up sun, fun, local live music and spirits at
