

It is an honour to be part of a collection that includes such remarkable new songs as John Bucchinos moving Grateful and If I Ever Say Im Over You, Jason Carrs ironic If I Really Wanted You and another new song When I See You, that suggests the style and classic structure of an undiscovered Irving Berlin ballad.
