This collection is straight ahead traditional country. Some songs grew up out of a title that came to mind and some were inspired by literature or a particular turn of events. The WIDOW MRS. WEST is a Marty Robbins style old west ballad. In my day job I appraise commercial real estate. Sharp production, the reverb effect is especially fine, solid playing and a strong female vocal. Theres something in the feel of the track that rivets your attention, then the lyric leaps right into the story. The writing is cinematic, the music makes the first killing sound even more dramatic and the chorus is very strong, a giant musical and lyrical hook.
