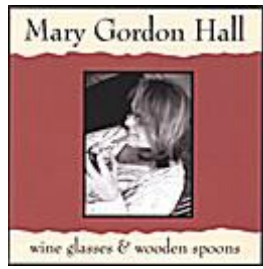


Mp3 Mary Gordon Hall - Wine Glasses & Wooden Spoons

Mary Gordon also was thrilled to have two of her favorite musical mentors from out of state, Sloan Wainwright and David Roth, share their talents on her album. *Wine Glasses Wooden Spoons* was co-produced and engineered by Jeff Romano of Greenwood Studio who helped bring the song collection to life. "Working with Mary Gordon was like being a kid again," said Romano. "The sessions with her mother were some of the most unforgettably fun times I've ever had in the studio. It was really easy to bring out MG's true musicality, and everyone else who contributed really put a perfect thumbprint there to invite the listener in. I'm really proud of this CD. It's like a welcome guest in my home." Not to be missed! SHORT BIO: Mary Gordon began her songwriting career about 20 years ago writing songs for children. Her first album, *I Won't Go to Bed Until I Sing My Song*, is enjoyed by families around the world. It will soon be re-released as a cd. More recently, though, she began to write and compose music for adults, and has performed in Central Virginia venues including First Night Virginia, Gravity Lounge, Mountain View Grill, Acoustic Muse, Acoustic Charlottesville, The Prism, and Rapunzel's.
