"When Matti died, I lost my best friend and soul mate," says Cary. "But I knew he wouldn't want me to lose sight of the dream. I wrote music because it was the only way I found to survive the greatest loss in my life to date. I picked up Matti's Martin and started playing because it was the only way I knew to keep the dream alive." Cary found solace in songwriting, and ultimately recorded her award-winning debut CD, New Shoes. In praise

of New Shoes, Billboard Magazine points to Cary's "poetic flair reminiscent of the initial efforts of The Indigo Girls and Shawn Colvin." Cary's sophomore release, *Onion Dream*, featuring lushly produced tracks as well as Cary's signature simple acoustic songs, has also received rave reviews. She has performed in more than 50 plays throughout the United States and Europe while simultaneously working in film, television and radio. Cary is a founding member of the NYC-based, Actor's Shakespeare Company.
