REDDEN Rev. Tina Redden Contralto Lead, made her singing debut at age 10, ordained a Reverend at 15 years old, worked as a missionary from age 10 and served as Pastor of two Churches. Her voice has been continuously compared to outstanding performers such as Mahalia Jackson and Mavis Staples, Dorothy Love Coates and Clara Ward. At times you can hear a hint of Sam

Cookes legendary "La Da Da". Pastor Redden, who plays a number of instruments (14 at last count) plays all instrumentals heard on the albums: Jesus Your My King Of Kings, His Inspiration, Who Do You Seek and One God; has been deemed a prodigy in the music world. Raised in a strict Pentecostal family, the youngest child of nine, born to a Minister father and a Missionary mother. She learned from an early childhood, the importance of singing to the Lord. Rev Tina served as adult choir director for four different churches in her home town of Michigan City at age 10 through 19. (even then hailed as "A God Anointed vocalist" and child prodigy) Listen and you'll agree, her powerful voice sends a message of spiritual hope, and an "I love you" to the Lord. Redden was destined to be a singer; named after the famed Tina Turner and Miss La Verne Baker (Tina La Verne Redden). Redden has traveled the Country over (numerous overseas show requests) performing with and without her former band, "The Spirit Of Truth". (Spirit Of Truth Band: key member suffered a stroke, and is recovering wonderfully, Thank the Lord) \* see bio for Spirit Of Truth Band Rev. Redden was given the task of singing for the US Troops (not USO) in the year of 2004 to many service persons spiritual delight. Having the long running Television Show "The Gospel Showcase" show of which; by popular demand has aired twice weekly, Redden is no stranger to sharing the stage with some of todays gospel greats as well as famed radio personalities many stating that "Rev's voice is identifiable: once you hear it; you know it whenever you hear it again, even if your in another Country." Bro. Terry L. Redden (Rev's Youngest Son) Aspired Minister; works as Mixer, CD/CD Jacket Designer and lighting specialist, tech support on all Reddens music. 2nd Degree Blackbelt in Tae kwon do; Heavyweight, Regional Champion. Reviewed by Phil Thomson Anarchic dissonance seeps out of every groove of these seven long songs; in other words, gospel with attitude, delivered so quirkily you just have to stick with it to find out where it's going to take you next. The arrangements are paired down to a dangerous minimum, the production has an almost amateurish innocence and the total effect of the package is absolutely electric. This Rev from Michigan City mesmerises with every breath; such an amazing voice, such sensitivity to her material - and no wonder when we discover her track record as a 12 year old performer, teenage missionary and pastor (ordained at 15) - one who just has to make her presence felt wherever she goes. You see, when a key band member fell ill, Tina Redden went into the studio anyway and played everything (14 different instruments), hardly breaking stride. She wrote the songs, so she knows her stuff. The result is such a wonderful take on how to communicate on a highly individual basis, and it works a treat. The effect is reminiscent of 1930's old time gospel without the crackle and hiss. Tina L Redden (the 'L' stands for Laverne - so you know where she's coming from) has to be the finest gospel vocalist in many a long year. Am I sounding positive enough? One final comment: the last track "The Day Christ Died", is probably the very best Christian soul track you will ever hear, and I really mean that. For collector, for connoisseur, for goodness sake, search this out. Rev Tina Redden's voice that dominates these recordings is reminiscent of the classic gospel sounds of a Clara Ward or a Dorothy Love Coates as she demonstrates she can swoop, holler and testify with the best of them. The group seem satisfied to sit on a groove and let the Rev do her thing. The majority of tracks are either inspirational material like "If I Had A Hammer" and "Down By The Riverside" or gospel remakes of classic soul tracks." I do like this a lot.
