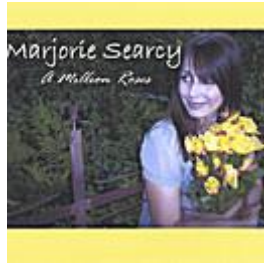


## Mp3 Marjorie Searcy - A Million Roses
