While very much her own artist, Raymond's music brings to mind free- spirited American female singers such as Rickie Lee Jones and Edie Brickell. As well as being singer songwriter, arranger, Raymond also plays lead guitar and harmonica and a blast of saxophone, while traversing a wide musical territory that draws on funk, soul, swing, reggae and folk stylings. Her original songs deal with relationships, mendesirable and dangerous- restlessness, melancholic days, pursuit of the simple life and the recovery of happiness. They are universal themes that she makes very personal through her writing and passionate singing.
