After their studies at the Conservatory of Perugia they took part in courses and master classes of G.Mortensen, D.Friedman, M.Rosen, R.Wiener, R.van Sice, D. Searcy, M.Quinn, R.Schulkosky, M. Ben Omar. They have regularly featured as orchestral percussionists in orchestras such as La Scala (Milan), RAI National Orchestra (Rome), Teatro Regio (Turin) Teatro San Carlo (Naples) Teatro Comunale (Florence), Accademia di Santa Cecilia (Rome), Teatro dell'Opera (Rome), Gustav Mahler Chamber Orchestra, Luzern Festival Orchestra, under the batons of conductors such as Claudio Abbado, Riccardo Muti, Carlo Maria Giulini, Giuseppe Sinopoli, Lorin Maazel, Daniel Harding, Georges Prtre, Daniel Oren, Mtislav Rostropovic, Gustav Kuhn, among many others. They are also much in demand as music teachers and presenters with their highly successful educational programs. With more than 250 concerts Tetraktis toured the U.S.A. twice and have brought their infectious playing in major concert seasons and festivals all over Italy as well as in Germany, Turkey, Nigeria and Sweden (invited by world leading ensemble Kroumata in joint performances of Steve Reichs Drumming).
