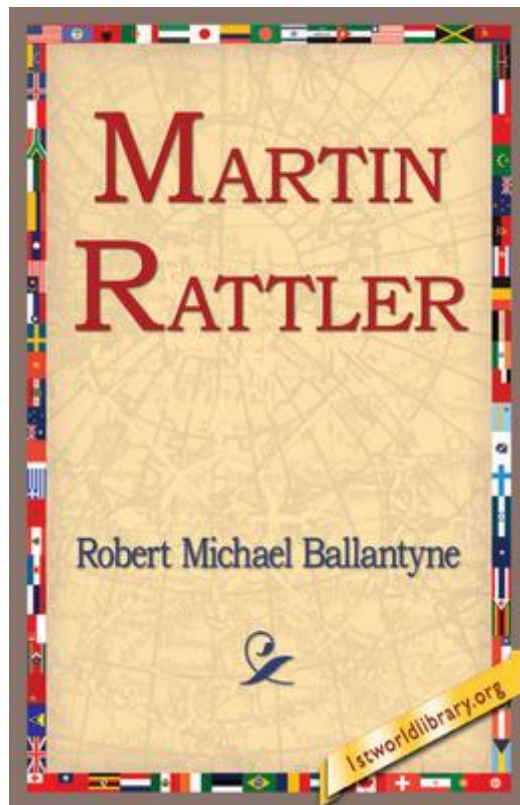


Martin Rattler - Robert Michael Ballantyne
