In the U.S, he was a favourite at the Taste of Chicago, The Old Town School of Folk Music and Front Porch Music. He has also performed in England, Cuba, Guatemala and Tibetan schools across the Indian Himalayas. In 2001 Chris brought his love of violin to young audiences and started touring his FiddleFire! concert for kids in festivals across Canada,

including the Distillery Jazz Festival in his home town. Chris has also brought FiddleFire! to Toronto Harbourfront's Cushion Concert series and headlined Toronto's First Night at the Skydome.
